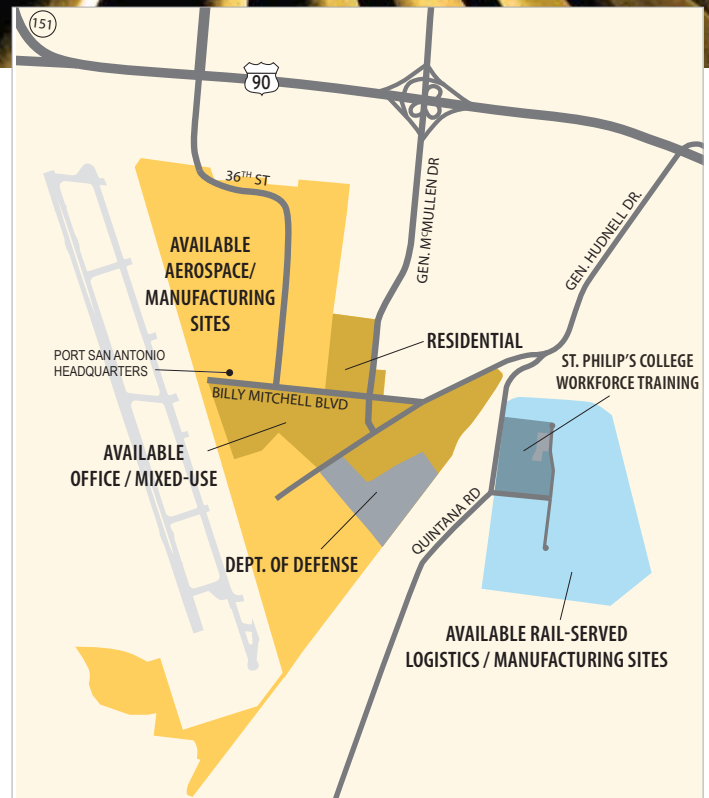
Port San Antonio is a fast-growing aerospace industry center and a strategic partner to customers at its industrial airport, Kelly Field (SKF), which also serves as a flexible logistics platform.

About Port San Antonio

Port San Antonio is redeveloping the former Kelly Air Force Base creating the conditions that maintain and grow quality jobs.

The 1,900-acre site features an industrial airport, railport and mixed-use development. Today the Port is home to over 70 private and public sector organizations which employ approximately 12,000 workers in aerospace, cybersecurity, military, logistics, manufacturing and other key industries in the region.



Building a 21st Century Workforce

The St. Philip's College Southwest Campus at Port San Antonio is the principal site for aerospace training in the region.

Fixed-Base Operator (FBO) – Atlantic Aviation is the on-site FBO at Kelly Field, offering airport customers a full range of fueling/de-fueling, maintenance/repair and aircraft storage services. For information, contact Atlantic Aviation at 210.921.6100 or www.PortSanAntonio.us/Atlantic



U.S. Customs – An on-site Federal Inspection Station (FIS) operated by U.S. Homeland Security is adjacent to Kelly Field and can promptly inspect foreign shipments entering the U.S., including agricultural products.



Foreign-Trade Zone (FTZ #80-10) – The entire Port San Antonio complex is covered by a general purpose U.S. foreign-trade zone designation, offering Port customers significant economic advantages, including deferral, elimination or reduction of import duties.
