

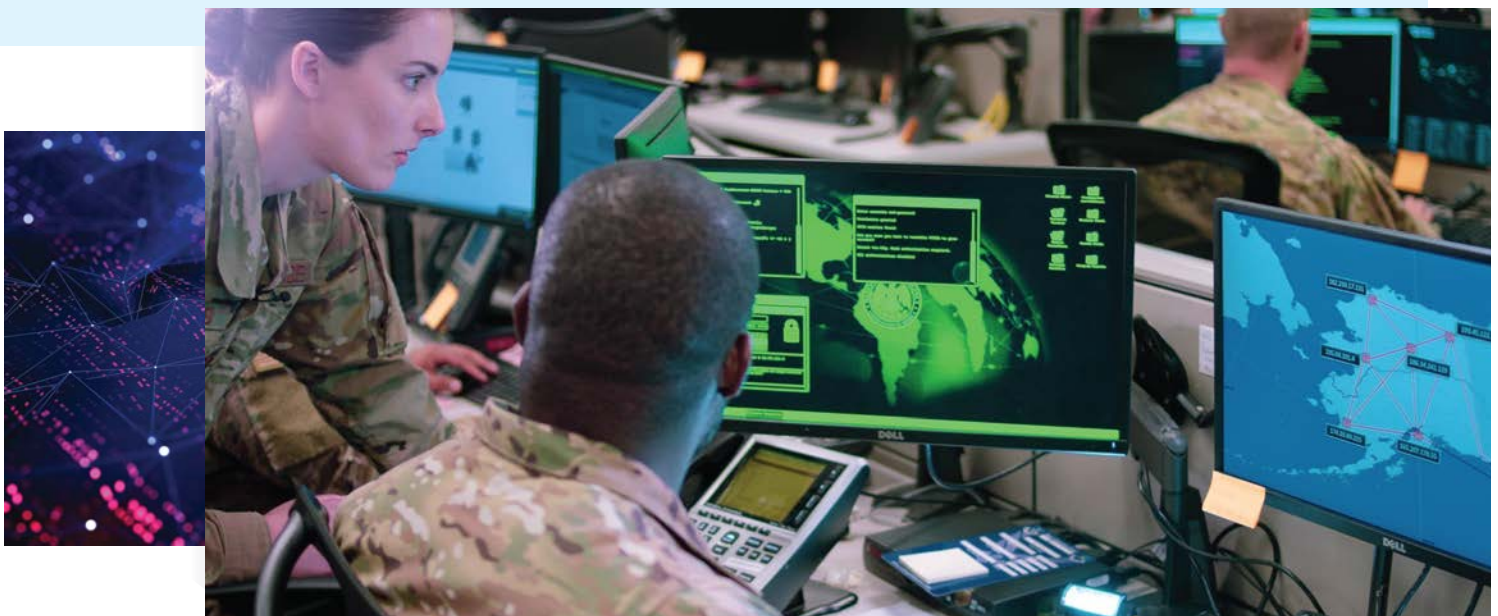


COMPREHENSIVE INDUSTRY SUPPORT

Private-sector firms are also growing at the Port. They're here to support Department of Defense cyber operations on our campus and throughout the region, as well as a growing private-sector clientele.



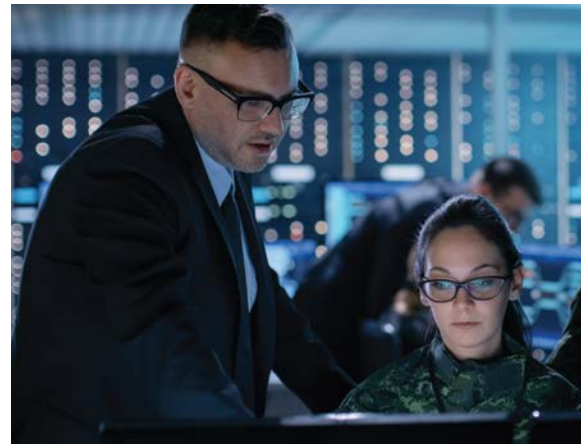
STRATEGIC SPACES
